

SE Dorset Transport Study - Composition of Consultative Groups

Details of the proposed Consultative Groups for the Transport Study Consultation Strategy follow below.

Strategy Advisory Group (SAG)

The Strategy Advisory Group will take the leading role in shaping the development of the transport strategy. The proposed Group includes key Member and Officer representatives from the 3 Local Highway Authorities, and Officers from the District Planning Authorities. It would also include the representatives of all the Transport Study Partnership organisations - HA, GOSW, SWRDA, SWRA]

Key officers from Local Authorities should include

- LTP Managers and or/ other senior Managers from Transportation Teams as appropriate
- Passenger Transport Managers
- Spatial/ Land Use Planners
- District Council Planning colleagues from EDDC, Purbeck and Christchurch

To facilitate meetings and decision-making process the Group should ideally be around 25 in number.
